Safe Medication Consumption During Your Hospital Stay

Important to note:

- Inform your nurse of your existing medications.
- Allow your nurse to temporarily keep your own medications.
- Consume only medications given by your nurse.
- Ask your doctor or nurse before you consume any long-term medications such as insulins, blood-thinners and traditional medicines.
- Inform your doctor, nurse or pharmacist if you have any type of drug or food allergy.



During your hospital stay

- All your medications, including long-term ones, will be reviewed by your doctor and pharmacist.
- Your doctor will prescribe appropriate medications for you based on your health condition.
- Your nurse will serve your medications to you timely.
- Inform your doctor or nurse if you have any concerns regarding the medication given to you.
