

Post Intravitreal Injection Advice

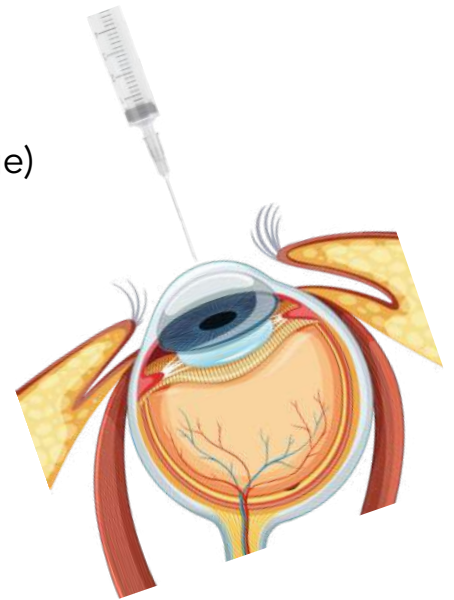
You have received an intravitreal injection into your eye:

It is normal to experience mild side effects such as:

- Eye discomfort
- Superficial bleeding (subconjunctival hemorrhage)
- Floaters (due to small air bubbles)

Please seek medical advice immediately if you experience any of the following conditions:

- Eye pain
- Increased blurring of vision
- Increasing eye redness
- Light sensitivity
- Numbness or weakness of your limbs
- Chest pain or chest tightness
