


Visudyne Therapy Patient Instructions

After each Visudyne therapy treatment:

Refrain from exposing eyes or skin to bright light for at least 48 hours.

"Bright light" includes but is not limited to:

- Bright sunlight
- Tanning salons
- Halogen lighting in homes and offices
- Lighting used in dentist's offices or in surgery operating rooms




- You are required to put on dark sunglasses and wear long-sleeved shirt when you are outdoor for 48 hours after each infusion.
- You should bring along your dark sunglasses and long-sleeved shirt for all return visits.
- It is still essential to apply sunscreen, especially if you are going to be exposed to sunlight.



Every three months after first therapy treatment:

- Your vision will be checked.
- A fluorescein angiogram (the dye test) and a series of photographs will be taken.
- Your doctor will see you after the photos have been processed.
- He/She will advise if another Visudyne therapy treatment is necessary.
